Radish: Multi-use

Crunchy King

This variety has excellent shape and uniformity. It has bright white interior with attractive dark red skin and is mid-early maturing. Crunchy King holds its round shape and does well all season, but it is strongest in fall and spring slots. It has very high recovery and is slow to pith.

- Mid-early maturity, mid top height
- Slow to pith, great internal quality
- Excellent uniformity



Radish: Bunch / Cello

Crunchy Royale

Crunchy Royale is a dark red, round radish ideal for bunching or cello pack. It yields high quality and extremely uniform roots. Overall, Crunchy Royale offers excellent internal and external color and a high pack-out rate for growers.

- Excellent uniformity
- Grows well under cool conditions
- Tolerant to pith



Radish: Bunch

Crunchy Red

Crunchy Red produces large tops and very uniform dark red, round roots. This variety is very slow to develop pith. It performs well under cool conditions. It's usually a few days earlier than standard O.P.s. Crunchy Red is desirable where larger roots are required.

- Get large-sized roots without pith in cool weather
- Excellent pith tolerance



Radish: Bunch / Cello

Cherriette

Cherriette is a warm season radish used in the fall and spring in most areas. It has a bright red color and short tops. This variety is uniform and slow to develop pith. Cherriette performs well under warmer conditions and yields better than O.P.s in its class.

- Short top type, very uniform size and shape
- Grows well in warm regions
- Tolerant to pith
