## Regal Red

Regal Red is a fast-maturing summer radish variety that produces uniform, round bulbs. It is a consistent performer in many regions of summer radish growing areas, as well as spring/fall seasons of winter radish growing areas, and has a medium-short top.

- Early maturity, 24 days
- Consistent, uniform, round shape in warm conditions
- Medium-short top

## Crunchy Delight

Crunchy Delight is a summer type radish that displays very nice uniformity and internal qualities. It is tolerant to cracking and pithing. Medium-height erect tops connect to consistently round bulb shaped fruit with a glossy scarlet red exterior and brilliant white interior. Crunchy Delight displays excellent yield potential, especially in Northern growing areas.

- Summer type radish
- Medium top height
- Consistent round shape

## Crunchy King

This variety has excellent shape and uniformity. It has bright white interior with attractive dark red skin and is mid-early maturing. Crunchy King holds its round shape and does well all season, but it is strongest in fall and spring slots. It has very high recovery and is slow to pith.

- Mid-early maturity, mid top height
- Slow to pith, great internal quality
- Excellent uniformity

## Crunchy Royale

Crunchy Royale is a dark red, round radish ideal for bunching or cello pack. It yields high quality and extremely uniform roots. Overall, Crunchy Royale offers excellent internal and external color and a high pack-out rate for growers.

- Excellent uniformity
- Grows well under cool conditions
- Tolerant to pith
