Tasty Green is resistant to powdery mildew and intermediately resistant to downy mildew. The fruit is nine inches long and 1.5 inches in diameter. This variety is suited for field or greenhouse culture. Tasty Green is Sakata's most popular burpless cucumber and a home garden industry standard.
