Rushmore (Hybrid)

Rushmore is a medium green, smooth leaf, slightly lobed spinach variety. It has a moderate growth rate and a moderate bolt tolerance. Rushmore has an upright plant habit and downy mildew resistance. It is well suited for late fall or early winter plantings.

- Upright plant habit
