Top Bunch 2.0 is an early maturing hybrid. It resembles Top Bunch with wavy, lightly savoyed leaves that regrow quickly after harvest. This variety is suitable for fresh market bunching and machine harvest for processing.

- Vigorous, rapid regrowth
