Top Chop is our slowest bolting hybrid variety, displaying great uniformity, upright habit, and large, wide leaves with a narrow rib for a bountiful harvest. Top Chop regrows quickly after cutting increasing yield over time. Works well in the overwinter slot or for spring plantings.
