Bella Luna

Bella Luna is a short day white onion variety with good yield and uniformity. It has pink root tolerance is exceptionally grower friendly.



Short Day

Red Sapphire

Red Sapphire is a vibrant red onion with strong plant growth and a sturdy root system. This globe-shaped variety has deep cherry red skin and ranges in size from jumbo to large. Red Sapphire is an overwinter short day onion with good pink root tolerance.



Intermediate

Spanish Medallion

Spanish Medallion is a late intermediate yellow that transitions into the long day Spanish types. It has firmness and excellent skin retention. This variety has a globe shape with sizes that range from colossal to jumbo. It cuts a high percentage of single centers. In the Pacific Northwest and Colorado, it is a true intermediate. In California and New Mexico, it is a good transitional variety.



Short Day

SON115Y

SON115Y is a short day onion that is colossal to jumbo in size with a soft tan color at maturity and a nice white interior color. With a slight Grano Taper in shape, SON115Y gives consistent yields with a strong plant and root system that makes it a great adaptable crop. This onion has good bolt resistance as well as Pink Root tolerance.

SON570W

SON570W is an intermediate white onion with great yield and a strong plant and root system, making it very adaptable in the field. This mid-late maturing onion has good pink root tolerance and bolt resistance.

Great Western

Great Western is a main season yellow intermediate onion. It can be grown in all intermediate growing areas including New Mexico. Great Western has good firmness with good skin retention. It will cut a high percentage of single centers and can be direct seeded or transplanted. This variety has strong plant growth with sizes that range from colossal to jumbo.

Ovation

Ovation is a late intermediate yellow that transitions into the long day Spanish type. Ovation has firmness and excellent skin retention. It offers a globe shape with sizes ranging from colossal to jumbo. In the Pacific Northwest and Colorado, Ovation is a main season intermediate. In California and New Mexico Ovation is a late/transitional intermediate into long day Spanish type.



Short Day

Super Luna

Super Luna is a short day white onion variety showing high yields and good uniformity. Super Luna has a brilliant white color and is a very grower friendly variety. In addition, this variety has moderate tolerance to pink root.



Intermediate

Yosemite

An intermediate day onion that has several layers of skin with good retention. This globe-shaped variety has vibrant brown skin and ranges in size from colossal to jumbo, with firmness and good single centers. Excellent uniformity and suited for export. Grower friendly!



Short Day

SON912Y

SON912Y is a short day variety that holds a slight Grano Taper in shape and runs colossal to jumbo in size with a nice tan color at maturity. This adaptable onion has a strong plant and root system which makes it a very grower-friendly crop with good yield. SON912Y has good bolt resistance and Pink Root tolerance.

SON950Y

SON950Y is a mid-season, long day onion with strong plant growth and a sturdy root system. This variety has vibrant brown skin and ranges in size from colossal to jumbo. SON-950Y also has good pink root tolerance.

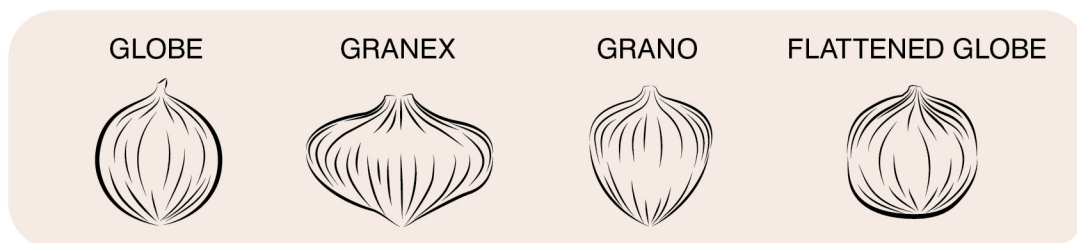
